- Administrative close-out is in progress.

PHASE 3A: Sheriff & Front Door

Status through 3/31/2017

- OSHPD Certificate of Occupancy for the canopy and temporary walkway was received on November 19, 2016.
- The front driveway opened in December 2016.

PHASE 3B: Demolition of H-Building

Status through 3/31/2017

- The roof of the Level 1 operating rooms has been demolished.
- Scaffolding now fully surrounds the H-Building up to Level 4.

PROCUREMENT: ECOP AND SLEB

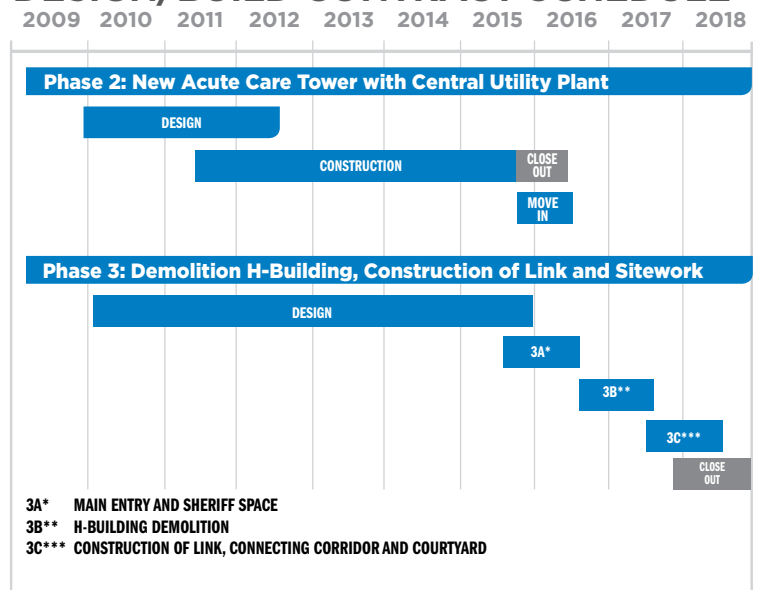
Status through 3/31/2017

- 106 ECOP Firms and 19 SLEB Firms: 68 total packages procured, with 41 of those packages let to ECOP firms for the Acute Care Tower Project.

The **Small, Local and Emerging Business (SLEB)** program is designed to enhance contracting and procurement opportunities that specialize in professional services and procurement of goods for small, local and emerging businesses within Alameda County. It also ensures that all local businesses are provided equal opportunities in County contracting and procurement activities.

The **ECOP (Enhanced Construction Outreach Program)** promotes construction contracting opportunities to local Alameda County contractors that are considered small, minority and women-owned business enterprises and its employment opportunities to local apprentices, youth, unemployed and underemployed County residents. The ECOP program applies to all capital projects approved by the Board of Supervisors.
