## BUILDING FOR A GREENER FUTURE

Highland Hospital's ATR Project is designed to conserve energy and promote sustainability. In accordance with the Green Building Ordinance enacted by the Alameda County Board of Supervisors, the new building will attain, at a minimum, a Silver certification through the national LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) program.

By conserving energy and increasing water efficiency, the ATR Project will allow Highland Hospital to focus its resources where they matter most: on providing and expanding high-quality healthcare to all people in our community, today and for many years to come.

## UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

### AUGUST - OCTOBER 2012

- Truck delivery of construction materials off of 14th Avenue to recycling center continues.
- Installation of site utility work for the Acute Care Tower completes in August.
- Site excavation for the Acute Care Tower starts August.
- Foundation preparation for the Acute Care Tower continues through September.
- Foundation construction for the Acute Care Tower begins in August.
- Installation of roof for the Highland Care Pavilion continues through August.
- Installation of exterior walls for the Highland Care Pavilion continues.
- Installation of interior walls, plumbing, HVAC and electrical for the Highland Care Pavilion continues.
