UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

DECEMBER 2012 - FEBRUARY 2013

- Site excavation for the Acute Care Tower is completed.
- Foundation construction for the Acute Care Tower continues into December.
- Basement level walls for the Acute Care Tower commence in December.
- Weekend work on the Acute Care Tower site for foundation and basement walls preparation may occur through December. No weekend work will occur before 9:00 am.
- Installation of site utility work for the Acute Care Tower continues through December.
- Installation of the structural steel for the Acute Care Tower begins in December through February.
- There will be occasional single lane 14th Avenue closure for delivery of building structural steel.
- Completion of exterior walls for the Highland Care Pavilion continues in December.
- Completion of interior walls, plumbing, HVAC and electrical for the Highland Care Pavilion continues.
- Weekend work within the Highland Care Pavilion may occur throughout December. No weekend work will occur before 9:00 am.
